The computer labs offers 15 computers both Windows and Apple Platforms, increased broadband speed, cover letter and resume writing assistance, job search and employment application assistance, and basic training on Microsoft Office programs.

The Housing Authority has also partnered with Career Institute, who will have an on-site staff member once a week to assist individuals with career, education and life planning.
